MEASURES RELATED TO SAFETY AND SECURITY

The College ensures utmost safety and security of its students and staff in the following ways:

- 1. Ragging is strictly prohibited in the campus. The College has an Anti-Ragging Cell to take care of any untoward incident in the campus.
- 2. Anti-ragging declarations are taken from all students during the time of admission as per UGC Guidelines.
- 3. A Grievance Box has been placed in the administrative building for receiving grievances form all the stakeholders.
- 4. Security guards are posted at the main gate of the College.
- 5. Identity Cards are issued to all students of the College.
- 6. Students are allowed entry to the College campus on producing a valid Identity Card, issued by the College.
- 7. Outsiders have to sign the Visitors' Logbook and enter relevant details for entering the College
- 8. The institution has a separate Common Room for its female students located at the administrative building ('Bankim Bhavan' or the Main Building) of the college.
- 9. There is provision of a separate washroom for female teaching and non-teaching staff.
- 10. There are two Sanitary Napkin-vending Machines: one in the Girls' Common Room and one in the space adjacent to the washroom for female teaching staff.
- 11. The Internal Complaints Committee (ICC) of the College ensures safety and security of the female students by organizing programmes on gender sensitization and women's rights. Awareness programmes are organized from time to time by the ICC.
- 12. The ICC of the College is there to address any complaint lodged by any female student/faculty member/staff related to any issue considered as sexual harassment.
- 13. There is a Health Unit under the Department of Physiology that conducts checking of blood pressure and blood sugar levels of students and staff members. The Health Unit arranges camps for determination of blood groups of newly-admitted students.
- 14. First-Aid Boxes are maintained by the College Office and the Health Unit.
- 15. Safe and purified drinking water facility is provided to students and staff. The College has its own water purification system with RO.
- 16. There exists a Code of Conduct for students, teachers and non-teaching staff members. As cadres under the West Bengal Education Service, the teachers and non-teaching staff members of this Government College are directly under the West Bengal Service Rules and have to abide by those.

PRECAUTIONARY MEASURES TO DEAL WITH COVID-19 SITUATION

The College has adopted several precautionary measures in order to deal with the COVID-19 situation. Following the declaration of a nationwide Lockdown due to the outbreak of the pandemic in 2020, the College remained closed for nearly the whole of the year, and all academic activities were conducted online. In between periodic Lockdowns due to the 2nd and 3rd waves of the pandemic in 2021, the College functioned offline in intermittent phases, by strictly following all COVID-19 related guidelines laid down by WHO, the Government of India and the Government of West Bengal.

The College authority is extremely particular about following the COVID-19 protocol and maintains strict adherence to all guidelines, till date.

The following measures have been adopted by the College to ensure strict adherence to **COVID-19 protocol:**

- 1. Wearing properly-fitted masks is mandatory for all students, teachers, non-teaching staff and visitors entering the College premises.
- 2. Maintenance of physical distance by students as they sit on the benches in a classroom is mandatory.
- 3. Gathering of students or gathering of any sort in any place in the campus is strictly prohibited.
- 4. Alcohol-based hand rub or hand sanitizer is readily available in the College office, the Principal's chamber, main staffroom, departmental staffrooms, toilets and washrooms, canteens, laboratories and the College Library.
- 5. A wall-mounted Hand-sanitizing machine has been installed in the ground floor of the Main Building.
- 6. The College Office is equipped with machines for spraying sanitizer in all the rooms and halls of the college.
- 7. The College Office can provide disposable surgical masks to any student or staff member if the need arises.
- 8. All washrooms and toilets are well-equipped with adequate soap and water.
- 9. All surfaces, especially furniture, door handles etc. are cleaned regularly.
- 10. If any student complains about feeling ill, he/she is immediately sent home and asked to remain isolated for at least 14 days.

POSH is the acronym for the Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act, implemented in 2013, by the Ministry of Women and Child Development, Govt. of India. The first Indian legislation specifically addressing the issue of sexual harassment in workplaces, POSH intends to ensure a safe working environment for women across the country, while it deems sexual harassment to be tantamount to the violation of women's fundamental rights, including their right to work with dignity in any profession, trade, or business. Not just physical contact but sexual remarks, sexually explicit pictures and even inappropriate advances made directly or via social networking sites come under its wide-ranging purview.

The current webinar is warranted by the urgent exigency of sensitizing our society, especially women, about the various dimensions and implications of this highly important and necessary Act.
