
RESOLUTIONS of the Meeting IQAC – 5

Minutes of the meeting held on 25th March, 2026

1. Preparation of AQAR – 2025:

It was resolved that the AQAR for the year 2025 would be prepared in accordance with prescribed guidelines and submitted within the stipulated timeframe. Data collection from all departments and committees has been completed, and the report is currently under final compilation and verification to ensure accuracy and compliance with quality standards.

2. Website Upgradation (Phase II):

The committee resolved to undertake Phase II of the college website upgradation to enhance digital accessibility, transparency, and dissemination of institutional information. A professional vendor has been engaged, and the development process is currently in progress. The upgraded website will include updated academic content, notices, research outputs, and user-friendly navigation features.

3. Wi-Fi Connectivity:

It was resolved to establish campus-wide Wi-Fi connectivity to support digital learning, research activities, and administrative operations. The installation process has been initiated, and partial coverage has already been achieved in key areas such as academic blocks and administrative offices. The remaining work is in progress and expected to be completed shortly.

4. Departmental Profile Upgradation:

The IQAC resolved that all departments should update their profiles, including faculty details, courses offered, achievements, and mentor-mentee records, to ensure proper documentation and readiness for accreditation processes. Most departments have submitted updated profiles, and the process of compilation, verification, and integration into institutional records is currently ongoing.

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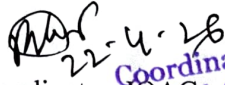
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5. Matters arising.
